PARKING C:

The parking is directly linked to ING Arena by a pedestrian bridge and a private road. Romeinsesteenweg, 1853 Strombeek-Bever – Capacity: 10.000 pl.

PARKING B, T, M:

They are located in the immediate vicinity of the ING Arena public entrance.

Parking B - Avenue Impératrice Charlotte, 1020 Brussels - Capacity : 267 pl.

Parking T - Avenue Impératrice Charlotte, 1020 Brussels - Capacity: 718 pl.

Parking M - Place de Belgique, 1020 Brussels - Capacity: 118 pl.

HANDICAPPED PARKING:

Anyone with a disability or reduced mobility, and in possession of a disability card or medical certificate (e.g. if the disability is temporary), can benefit from our PRM services.

Parking E (fee-paying), located right next to the public entrance to the ING Arena, has spaces specially reserved for PRMs and disabled people. It is not possible to reserve a space in advance. Parking is located in the LEZ zone of Brussels.

Parking C (paying) also has a few PRM spaces, but be aware that Parking C is much farther from the venue, and accessibility is less easy than from Parking E.

BUS PARKING:

Free bus parking is available. Contact the Festival of Hope Festival office for more information on bus parking passes and designated parking locations.

ING Arena is easily accessible by car or public transport.

CAR

If you are coming from GHENT, MONS, or CHARLEROI (via the E40 or E19), take the Ring RO, direction Zaventem - Namur (Namen). On the Ring, take exit 7A and follow the signs for "Expo."

If you are coming from ANTWERP, NAMUR, or LIEGE (via E19, E411, or E40), take the Ring RO, direction Gent (Ghent) – Oostende (Oostende) (E40). On the Ring, take exit 7A and follow the "Expo" signs.

If you are coming from ANTWERP or BOOM (via A12), take the Ring RO, direction Gent (Ghent) - Ostend (E40) - Mons (Bergen) / Charleroi (E19). On the Ring, take exit 7A and follow the signs "Expo".

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Several streetcar, metro, and bus lines are available for easy access to ING Arena. Find your best route with the STIB. No ticket yet? No problem; scan your contactless bank card directly in the metro, streetcar, or bus and travel on the entire STIB network for just $\ensuremath{\in} 2,10$.

Metro: 6 (Heysel)

Tram: 3 (Esplanade), 7 (Heysel)
