

Assignments for Servants of the Most High God. | DARE YOU!



BETWEEN NOW AND THE NEXT SESSION:

Practice a couple things that should become a normal way of life for any Christian.





SECOND, be on the alert and ready to help, serve, and meet needs for others. Don't wait to be asked to do things. Instead, take the initiative, find out what needs to be done, and do it.

In the process of serving others, look for opportunities to talk about spiritual issues and bring God into the conversation. While you must be willing to help, serve, and show kindness without any expectation of getting something in return, it is certainly appropriate to start conversations with those you serve—especially if they ask why you're doing what you're doing. You could be direct and say, "God's been good to me, and I want to pass that on." Or you could be more subtle and try to bring your church into the conversation if people start talking about things in which they're involved. You could even tell them that you participated in a class (this Dare to Be a Daniel course) that challenged you to be more



helpful. Any of these things could lead to deeper conversations about faith and God. Always look for ways to draw attention to Christ.
