DON'T BE AFRAID OF CHANGE.

As we considered in the group session, having more effective influence for Jesus may require making some changes in your life and friendships. With God's help, you can make these changes for the better. Use the space below to evaluate the changes that need to take place in your life.

1. Who you are and how you act can speak louder than what you say. Effectively influencing others to trust Christ takes more than having the guts to tell people about Jesus. It means that how you think and act needs to be consistent with what you say. Does this mean that you have to be perfect to be an effective witness? Of course not. But your relationship with Jesus should be getting stronger and more consistent so people get a good idea of what it means to follow Jesus by looking at you.



Take some time to think and pray about particular areas where your actions may not line up with God's instructions. Write some specific things you are going to do about this. (For example, STOP lying, swearing, gossiping, losing your temper; START praying more, being nicer to your brother or sister, doing your best in school, etc.)
