



# Cove Programs

## **AN EVENING AT THE COVE and CHRISTMAS AT THE COVE**

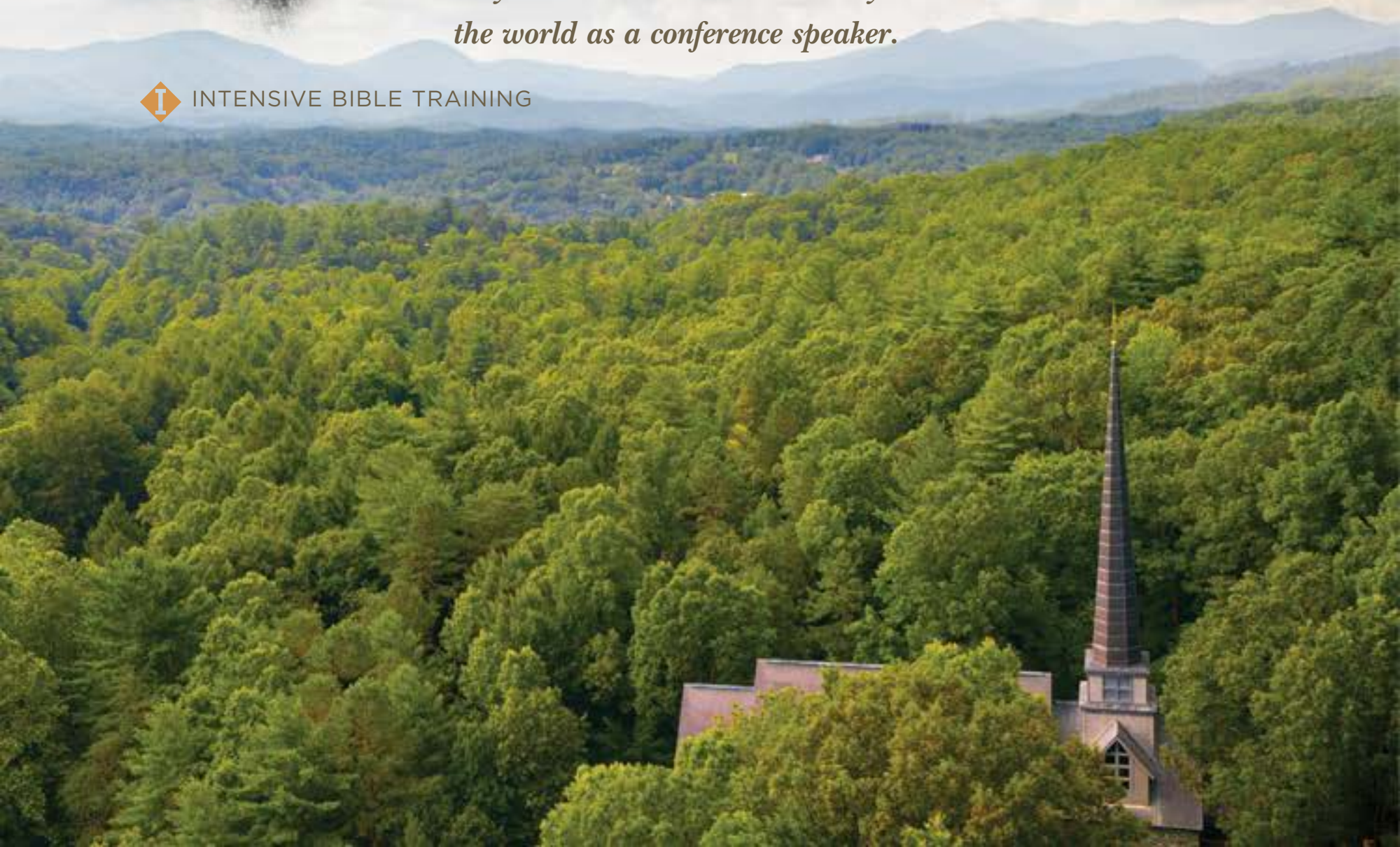

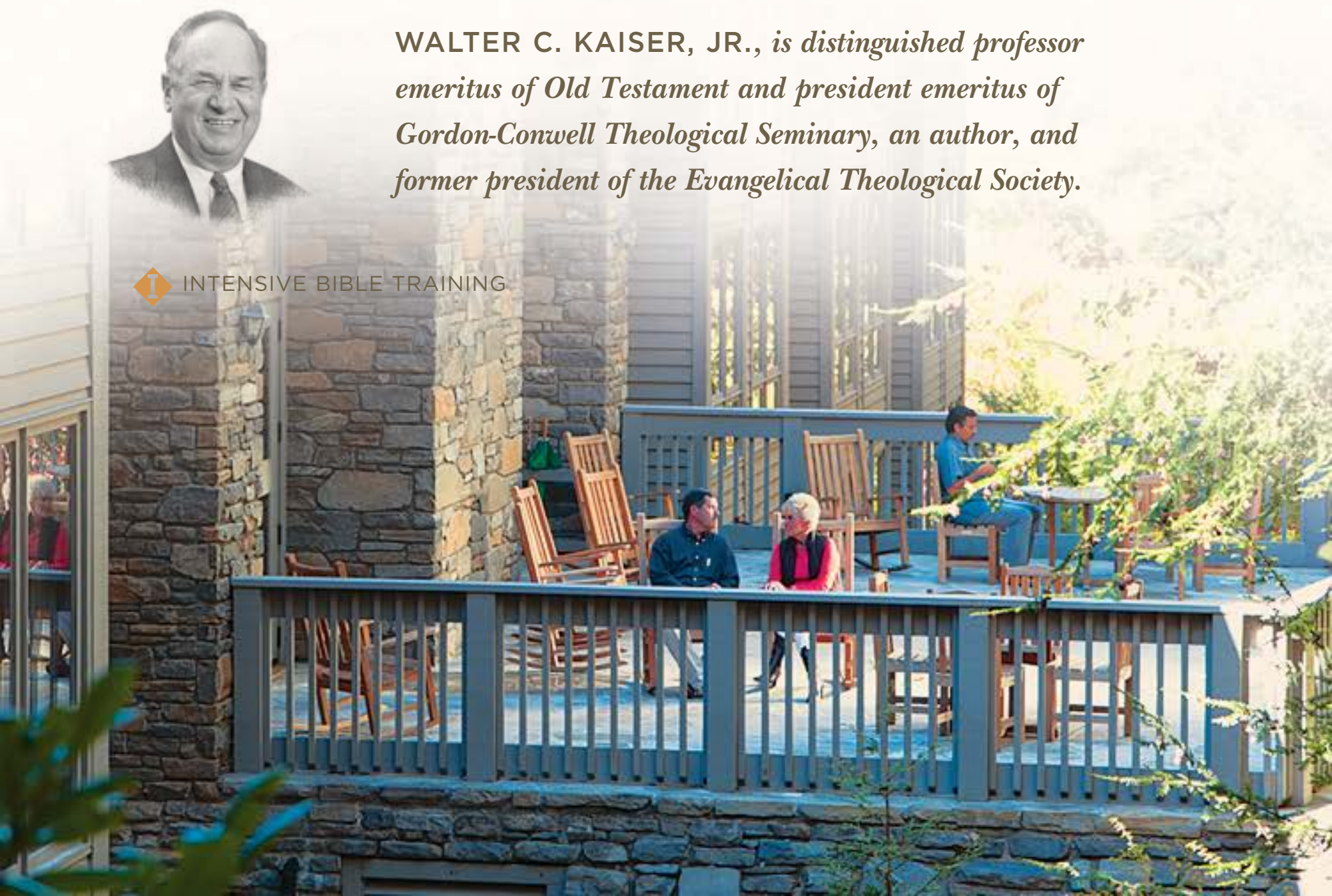
