Cove Programs

offer life-changing Bible teaching, soul-stirring worship, and the fellowship of those who hunger to know God more deeply. AN EVENING AT THE COVE and CHRISTMAS AT THE COVE

Each program features a concert by a popular Christian artist and a savory buffet dinner prepared by our chefs. Youth ages 9 and up may participate.

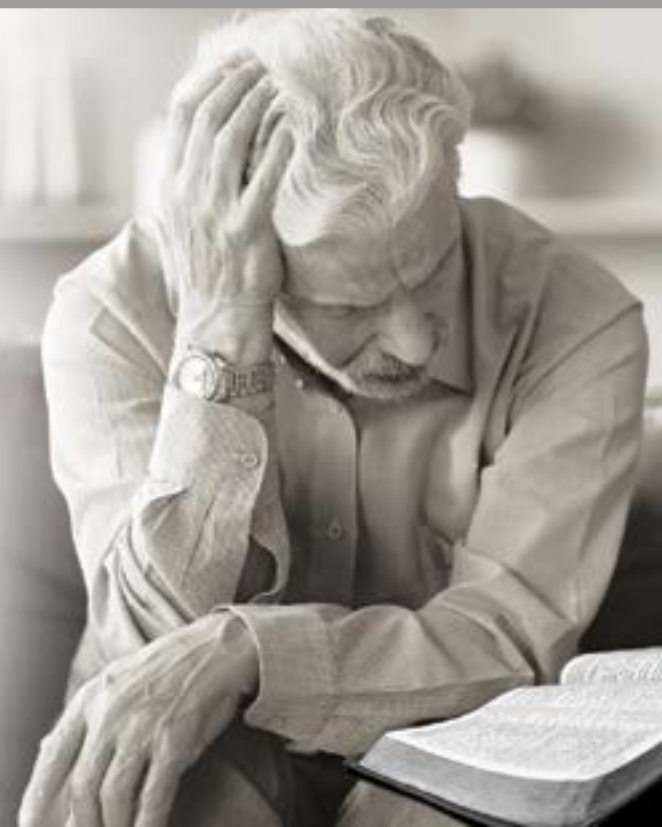
